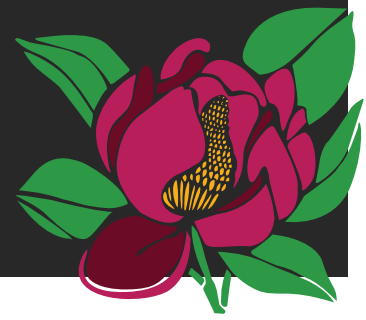

VARIETY	POLLEN	SEASON	DESCRIPTION	USE
Brown Turkey	Self	August	Medium size fruit with mahogany brown skin tinged purple. Very few seeds. Sugary rich flavor. Grows 10'-15'.	Good for jams, canning, drying or eating fresh.
Desert King	Self	Two crops: Aug./Sept.-Oct.	Large fruit with dark green skin. Violet pink flesh is very sweet. Hardier. Ripens even at the coast. Bears heavy. Grows 5'-10'.	Great fresh or dried.
Latterula	Self	Two crops: Early Aug./Sept.-Oct.	Medium size fruit with greenish yellow skin. Honey colored flesh. Many seeds. Hardier. Grows 15'-20'.	Good all purpose.
Negronne	Self	Two crops: Aug./Sept.-Oct.	Small black fruits with tasty, sweet deep red flesh. Excellent for cooler climate areas. Vigorous and extremely hardy. Dwarf tree.	Fresh or dried.
Oregon Prolific	Self	Two crops: Aug./Sept.-Oct.	Green yellow fruit, tasty and productive. Good habit, well adapted to the NW. Grows 15'-20'.	Fresh, canned.
Stella	Self	August	Green skin with delicious, sweet, dark pink-red flesh. Very hardy. Found in Portland, brought here by an Italian sailor.	Fresh, dried
Vern's Brown Turkey	Self	July-Aug.	Bears reliably in PNW, prolific crops of sweet, delicious brown figs with light amber flesh. Grows to 10'.	Fresh, dried, canned, jam
