macropetala Blue Bird	Mauve-blue nodding flowers	April-May	8-12'	1/sh

tex. Gravetye Beauty	Rich red upright bell-shaped flowers with paler exterior color. Attracts hummingbirds	July-Sept	6'-8'	3/con
tex.Princess Diana	Pink tulip-like flowers with deep pink central bar	July-Sept.	5'-8'	3/sh
viticella Alba Luxurians	Nodding white bell-shaped white flowers with purple-black stamens	July-Sept.	10'-12'	3/sh
vit. Etoile Violet	Very floriferous with single, semi-nodding, deep purple flowers	Mid summer-early fall	10'-13'	3/sh
vit. Mdme Julia Correvon	Single, semi-nodding, vibrant rich claret red 2"-4" with scalloped, recurved tepals	Mid-late summer	10'-13'	3/sh/con
vit.Negritjanka	Deep purple, almost black 5" flowers	Mid-summer-early fall	8'-10'	3/sh
vit. Polish Spirit	Single open dark purple velvety 3.5" flowers	Mid-summer-early fall	8'-10'	3/sh
vit. Prnce Charles	Pale mauve semi-nodding flowers	Mid-summer-early fall	8'-10'	3/sh
vit. Royal Velours	Wine red velvety flowers	Mid-summer-early fall	5'-8'	3/sh
vit. Venosa Violaceae	Single open 4" flowers with 5-6 tepals are white with deep purple veining, becoming more intense towards the edges.	Mid summer-early autumn	8'-10'	3/sh
