Lonicera heckrottii	Gold Flame Honeysuckle	12′-16′	5'-8'	Clusters of fragrant 1 ½" tubular flowers are bright coral pink outside and cantaloupe-orange inside in summer. Blue-green semi-evergreen foliage. Hardy to -20. Sun.
Lonicera japonica Halliana	Hall's Honeysuckle	20-25'+	12'-16'	Semi-evergreen, fast-growing twining vine bears very fragrant white tubular flowers that turn yellow as they age. Blooms late spring through summer. Hardy to -20F. Sun.
Lonicera japonica Purpurea	Purple-leaf Japanese Honeysuckle	20′-25′	5'-8'	Fragrant purplish-red flowers with white insides age to yellow, blooms all summer. Attracts hummingbirds. Semi-evergreen foliage is green above & purple underneath. Hardy to -10. Sun.
Lonicera x Mandarin	Mandarin Honeysuckle	15'-20'	5′-8′	Twining vine with intense orange tubular flowers in late spring through summer. Attracts hummingbirds. Deciduous. Hardy to -30F.
Lonicera periclymenum Harlequin	Harlequin Honeysuckle	10'-15'	3'-5'	This twining honeysuckle has variegated blue-green leaves with cream edges and delightfully fragrant soft pink and cream blossoms late spring through summer. Attracts hummingbirds. Hardy to -20F. Sun or part-shade.
Lonicera sempervirens Magnifica	Trumpet Honeysuckle	12'	5'-8'	Semi-evergreen twining vine with trumpet-shaped coral-orange flowers in summer. Hummingbirds love it! Blooms on old & new growth so can be pruned if desired. Hardy to -10 F. Sun or part-shade.
Lonicera s. Major Whheler	Major Wheeler Honeysuckle	6′-10′	5'-8'	Twining vine covered with scarlet red tubular flowers with golden-orange centers all summer that hummingbirds love. Bluish-green, mildew resistant foliage. Hardy to -20 F.
