Consort	Self	Black	Small to medium berries have a classic, musky flavor. Shrub is productive and excellent to use as bird forage or windbreak. Ripens in mid summer.	Great for juice or wine, dried, in jams, as flavoring.
Red Lake	Self	Red	Vigorous bush produces medium-sized, rich red berries with excellent, tangy flavor. Ripens in mid summer.	Perfect for baked goods, preserving, juice.
White Primus	Self	White	Near-translucent berries are impressively sweet and very high in vitamin C. Shrub is compact but heavily produces. Ripens in mid summer.	Superb when fresh. Good as flavoring, jams, adorning baked goods.
